THE ZAMBIA NKRUMAH LIVING THE LEGACY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARD



1. Candidates must have a 2.5 GPA and provide documentation
2. Candidates must be actively involved in their community/extracurricular activities
3. Candidates must have two(2) adult recommendations (One from a teacher/counselor and one from an adult mentor)
4. Complete a 500-word essay entitled, *"What Will Be My Living Legacy?"*

AWARDS/DISBURSEMENT

1. Applicants will be notified of selections by Friday, March 31, 2017.
2. The Living the Legacy Committee will present awards at the Living the Legacy Gala. This event begins at 7:00p.m.
3. Recipients **MUST BE PRESENT** (have representative) at the Living the Legacy Gala.
